About Our Next Preaching Minister:

Using 1 Corinthians 4 as a guide, we are:

- seeking a man who others can imitate in Christ.
- seeking a man who can provide guidance and wisdom for others.

Qualifications:

Committed to a healthy, Christ-centered marriage.

Experience in full-time ministry/preaching in churches of Christ.

A bachelor's degree in Biblical Studies or a relevant field of study.

The ideal candidate will have pursued or is currently pursuing advanced study in biblical courses at the graduate level.

Major Duties and Responsibilities:

- Preaches and teaches the Word of God during Sunday morning worship services. May also be asked to present lessons Sunday evening and Wednesday evening, as determined by the elders and education committee.
- 2. Articulates and models the mission, values, and theme of the church as established by the elders.
- 3. Updates the elders regarding perceived physical and spiritual needs of the church family.
- 4. Coordinates with worship leaders to facilitate between the various components of the worship assembly so that members will experience meaningful worship and that God will be glorified.

Additional Roles:

- 1. Act as the face of the congregation and is a dynamic and inspirational speaker.
- 2. Support the spiritual direction of the elders in sermon topics presented and in matters concerning the flock.
- 3. Articulate and model the mission and values established by the elders.
- 4. Understand the importance of and maintain balance between both biblical teaching and preaching with gospel outreach.
- 5. Demonstrate the ability to communicate well with various generational, socio-economic, and ethnic groups.

Other Duties and Responsibilities Include:

- 1. Supervisory responsibility for office staff.
- 2. Lead weekly staff meetings, concentrating on team building, collaborative learning, and effective interaction between ministries.
- 3. Attend and actively participate in elder meetings and other meetings as requested.
- 4. Coordinate activities of the ministerial team, in concert with the administrative elder.
- 5. Provide personal consultation to the church family members as needed and as appropriate.
- 6. Keep elders abreast of church family needs as needed and as appropriate.
- 7. Provide personal Bible studies with those inside and outside the church family.
- 8. Maintain an active presence in community affairs.

Nature, Qualities and Characteristics Of Our Next Preacher:

In consideration of results from a survey recently completed by our church family, our next preacher must be a man who encourages, inspires, motivates, and equips the church family with spiritual nourishment by preaching and teaching God's word through Biblical applications as well as through family examples. He must be a good intergenerational communicator who can relate to the entire church family; to individual family members, young families, college students, young professionals, guests, and to our community. He must possess excellent leadership skills.

The preaching minister is the face of our congregation. He needs to instill into the church family the love of Jesus while equipping family members with love, acceptance, and encouragement to all members and guests.

Why Are We Looking For A New Preacher?

For the past 6 1/2 years, brother Jimie-Wray Mead has served as our preaching minister. He informed us of his desire to move closer to his family, thus creating a need for this search. Jimie-Wray has done outstanding work during his time in Stillwater, and has left the role in very good shape for our next preaching minister. Jimie-Wray loves the Stillwater church and leaves us with no ill-will and no problems in the church here.

The elders feel God has given us plenty of work to do, so the next preaching minister will have the freedom to bring his unique God-given gifts and perspectives to the team to help shape the next chapter in the history of the Stillwater church.

History Of The Stillwater Church Of Christ:

In 1899, members of the church of Christ, principally from Kentucky and Arkansas, settled north and west of Ripley, Oklahoma and built the Mt. Hope church of Christ. From this beginning, a congregation was established in Ripley in 1915. In 1920, the Ripley Christians helped establish the church in Stillwater.

The Stillwater church of Christ first met in the McWethy home at 609 W. Sixth, then in a rented upstairs hall at 120 E. Ninth, and in 1926 built a building at 208 W. Tenth. In 1939, the church rented the old South Methodist building at Sixth and Husband; it was purchased in 1944 and enlarged and remodeled in 1948. On August 19, 1962, worship services were first held in a newly constructed building at the corner of Duck and McElroy. A large classroom/fellowship hall was constructed in 1980. This building serves as our current location.

Christians from Ripley were motivated to build a strong congregation in Stillwater because of the unique opportunity to reach, teach, and spiritually motivate young people who came to Stillwater to study at the university. The Stillwater church has always considered the university campus its primary mission field and since 1964 has shared in a special ministry to international students and their families.
